Distributing the petition

Signatures Use pen only, preferably with waterfast ink. Only allow requested

information to be added to page, if additional marks or comments are placed

on the page it may render the entire page invalid.

<u>Details</u> The postcode is not mandatory nor is the person's name, however please ask

for these to be completed unless there is a strong objection as it will aid

collation.

Printing Please print the petition single sided.

Where does the petition go?

The petition, when completed, will be lodged with the Petitions Officer - Senate Table Office to ensure conformity with Senate Standing Orders governing petitions. The text of the petition, once received, will be printed in Hansard.

Returning signed petitions

Please note that only original pages are acceptable, faxed or photocopied pages will be rejected.
