- 15:49 LiamPomfret I see, thanks for the clarification.
- 15:49 daemon_singer re Angus1 comment, fundraising is not the actual problem. The problem is getting more than 3 people to stick their hands up top not just sit on committees but actually get in and plan/execute stuff
- 15:50 daemon_singer @davecake- true but the ongoing life membrship issue is problematic
- 15:50 davecake But we have had to rely on corporate donors. Google has been a major donor. We are very aware of the possibilities for conflict of interest (both board and Google) and careful to avoid it. We would like to diversity so we are not reliant on any large donor.
- 15:51 davecake I personally do not believe that thinking of the life member program as the problem is a helpful way of framing the problem. While it is true that someone who joined as a life

member in the 1990s is not contributing to the organisation, it is unreasonable to expect that we would usually get a long term commitment of that level. We need to grow member contributions and fundraising in general - the many life members are mostly a
